

SOME HIGHLIGHTS

Park Village and Bankside Gardens are impressive. They include a new primary school, senior living Extra Care Home and an onsite train station. This is enhanced by Green Park Business Park which offers a gym, restaurant and retail facilities, only a short walk from your home. There is also a proposed flexible commercial unit located in the Market Square at Green Park, and two further commercial units

located at Bankside Gardens.*

READING GREEN PARK STATION

This brand new station on the Reading to Basingstoke line will provide Crossrail connections at Reading. It's due to open in Summer 2022[†].

THE MARKET SQUARE

AT THE HEART OF THE DEVELOPMENT

The Market Square is located at the heart of Green Park Village. Situated next to the primary school and Extra Care accommodation, this is the place you will gravitate to when meeting friends or stopping to enjoy the water feature. The proposed commercial unit located here benefits from ample outside seating with views to the lake.

A convenience food store and further retail unit are just a short walk away at Bankside Gardens, next to the new train station and Community Hub.

BACK TO NATURE


The nature trail follows the wooded edge of the park towards the lake.



PLENTY TO DO IN THE LOCAL AREA



NATURE ALL AROUND YOU



Untamed open spaces and smaller parks, nature reserves, woodlands and commons can all be found close to Green Park Village and Bankside Gardens. If you're interested in nature, birdwatching or simply want a family day out where there's fun and adventure to be had, you'll find the kind of outdoor life to suit you.

SOME HIGHLIGHTS

PROSPECT PARK

Named after the views over the Kennet Valley, this park is a great favourite with children who can ride the mini steam train and burn off excess energy in the play area.

FOBNEY ISLAND

Newly created wetlands along the River Kennet, where over 100 species of bird have been seen.

SWINLEY FOREST

2,600 acres of woodland, close to Bracknell, where the adventures include a Go Ape tree top experience and 15 miles of mountain bike trails.

DINTON PASTURES COUNTRY PARK

Vast country park near Wokingham, with sports and activities for all ages. Its beautiful lakes can be used for sailing and fishing.

WINDSOR GREAT PARK

This magnificent Royal Park is famous for its Long Walk, the Savill Garden and Virginia Water - with the iconic castle overlooking it all.

WOKEFIELD COMMON

A tranquil spot near Burghfield Common, where you can wander peacefully through the pine and broadleaf woodland.





THE GREEN VILLAGE

Without doubt, the green space of Green Park Village and Bankside Gardens is one of its greatest assets. It is a very varied landscape too. The lake is the main feature, but it also includes ecological areas, wooded areas, meadows, picnic spots, walks and trails. LANDSCAPING & PLAY SPACES


Designed by award-winning landscape architects Macfarlane Associates, the extensive landscaping and seasonal planting can be appreciated all year round by residents.

National Cycle Route 23 runs through the Green Park Business Park, connecting Reading to Basingstoke and beyond as far as Southampton. Cyclists have secure bike storage on the development.

Reading has an extensive bus network with several stops within Green Park.

St Edward is committed to protecting A large lake and balancing pond and enhancing the ecology around its sites. Within and around Green Park Village and Bankside Gardens, we have created natural habitats that encourage wildlife to flourish.

The landscape planting includes new evergreen, herbaceous and perennial species.


OUR PLANTING LEGACY
