Welcome to Horlicks Quarter – an amazing new neighbourhood in Slough, in the county of Royal Berkshire, just 6.4 km (4 miles) from historic Windsor and just one stop (15 minutes) by train to London.

Here, on the site where the globally-popular malted milk drink Horlicks was produced for more than a century, you will find quality new homes set in beautiful surroundings, landscaped parks and gardens with tranquil water features. There is a central square with a proposed café, nursery, gym, cinema room and many more residents' facilities.

Slough sits at the heart of beautiful countryside, close to some of southern England's most picturesque towns and villages, including Henley-on-Thames, famous for rowing on the River Thames, and Bray with its six Michelin-starred restaurants. There is so much to do and see here – from the majestic Burnham Beeches wood and golf at nearby Stoke Park Country Club, to excellent shopping at Windsor and Westfield London.

Slough has twice been voted the UK's best place to live and work in the last few years*. It is currently undergoing a major town centre regeneration, of which Horlicks Quarter is an integral part. Few other towns can boast such a wealth of amenities – great transport connections, top schools, shopping, parks, sports and leisure facilities.

SLOUGH - A CENTRE OF INNOVATION AND INVENTION FOR 250 YEARS

Many things have been said about Slough, but did you know about the spirit of innovation and enterprise that has shaped the town for generations?

A surprising number of things that are now part of our everyday culture began life in Slough. The first zebra crossing was piloted in the town. Mars Bars – the chocolate, toffee and nougat confectionery that's been helping us work, rest and play since 1932 – was invented in Slough.

Slough was the adopted home of German astronomer William Herschel, who first identified Uranus and infra-red radiation, among many significant discoveries.


Motor racing fans may know that Slough was the HQ of Ford Advanced Vehicles. In the 1960s, the Le Mans-winning Ford GT40, designed to break Ferrari's dominance of the 24-hour endurance race, was assembled here.


Creativity and the arts are part of Slough's history too. There are film studios at nearby Bray and Pinewood, home of 007 and Star Wars. In the 1960s, the animator Gerry Anderson set up a studio on Slough Trading Estate where his team made the inimitable Thunderbirds series, so fondly remembered by everyone between the ages of 7 and 70.

Enterprise and innovation continues to thrive. Today's Slough is forwardthinking, dynamic, full of purpose and vitality. Futuristic new architecture features prominently in the regenerated townscape. Slough is home to global headquarters, a high concentration of hi-tech companies and has one of the most successful new business start up rates outside of London.*

A CENTRE FOR EDUCATION

When it comes to getting a great education, Slough has some of the best schools, both state and independent, for all ages from nursery to university postgraduate. Add in the wider Berkshire and Buckinghamshire area, and the choice of high performing educational establishments is even better. An exceptionally high percentage of schools in Slough have been classed as Outstanding or Good by Ofsted or Independent Schools Inspectorate.

Berkshire operates a selective 11+ system and many of its grammar schools rank highly among the best performing in the UK. Within a few minutes drive or a train journey from Horlicks Quarter are some of the UK's most prestigious independent schools including Heathfield School, St George's Ascot, Wellington School and Eton College, alma mater of 19 British Prime Ministers including David Cameron and Boris Johnson.







TOP RANKING UNIVERSITIES EASILY ACCESSIBLE

For those attending the great higher education establishments in central London, Horlicks Quarter offers a convenient and viable alternative to living in the Capital, where accommodation rates and rents can be prohibitive for students.

The train service from Slough connects to London Paddington station in as little as one stop (15 minutes) by train in peak times. This puts world-renowned centres of learning, including King's College, Imperial College, University College London and the LSE, within easy daily reach.

Outside of London, equally eminent universities include the world-renowned Oxford University, which can be reached in one stop (40 minutes) by train. The University of Reading, which incorporates the famous Henley Business School is 29.8 km (18.5 miles) away. Royal Holloway University, which has a reputation in business, science and engineering is 11.8 km (7.3 miles) away, and there are proposals to open an additional facility in Slough.

At Junction 6, take the A355 exit to Slough Central/Windsor A332. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Tuns Lane/A355.

By car from London M4

At Junction 6, take the A355 exit to Slough Central/Windsor A332. At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Tuns Lane/A355.

From Tuns Lane/A355

At traffic light junction turn right onto Bath Road/A4 and continue to follow A4 (passing Salt Hill Park). Continue along A4 until you reach Stoke Road/B416 junction. Turn left at traffic lights onto Stoke Road (Slough Bus Stop and Train Station on your right hand side). Over the railway bridge at next traffic light junction turn left onto Stoke Gardens.

By foot from Slough Station

Exit the station via Platform 5 and turn left onto Railway Terrace. At the end of Railway Terrace turn right onto Stoke Road/B416. At the next junction turn left onto Stoke Gardens.
